ENGLISH—4 Credits			
ESL I, II, III, IV or English 9, 10, 11, 12—(ESL English as a Second Language) Reading, Writing and Grammar required each year. *

MATHEMATICS—4 Credits			
Any four (4) Math credits of choice depending on student goals. Integrated Math I, II, III, IV, Algebra 1, Algebra 2, Geometry, Calculus, Statistics, Accounting, Business Math, or other math courses.

NATURAL/PHYSICAL SCIENCES—3 Credits			
Any three (3) Science credits of choice depending on student goals. Integrated Science courses, Biology, Physics, Chemistry or other science courses. If the curriculum you are using includes Biology or Physics every year of High School then list the course as Biology 09, Biology 10, etc and Physics 09, Physics 10, etc

SOCIAL STUDIES—3 Credits			
Any three (3) Social Studies credits of choice depending on student goals. History of your country, World History and Geography, Government, Macro/micro Economics, U.S. History (US History is required for US Citizens/Families), or other social studies courses

PERSONAL FINANCE—0.5 Credit			
Any .5 credit, 1 semester course that teaches about how to handle money well and covers topics such as saving, budgeting, taxes, etc
